REVIEW DEFINITION OF A FAN

- A FAN IS "AN ENTHUSIASTIC ADMIRER". SOME ONE WHO CHEERS, BUT IS NEVER IN THE GAME. IT IS LIKE SOME ONE AT A GAME WHOM SUPPORTS A TEAM, BUT WHEN THEY BEGIN TO FAIL, JUMP SHIP.
- FANS CONFUSE ADMIRATION WITH DEVOTION
- MISTAKE KNOWLEDGE WITH INTIMACY.
- CONFUSE FEELINGS WITH FAITH (JAMES 1:7)

REVIEW DEFINITION OF A FOLLOWER

- ACCEPTS THE INVITATION (MAT. 16: 24)
- **DENIES THEMSELVES (MAT 19: 16 21)**
- HAS "COME-AFTER" (HAVE A PASSIONATE PURSUIT)
- LOVES JESUS MORE THAN OTHER THINGS IN LIFE (JN. 21: 15-17)
- COMMITTED (JN. 6: 66 69)
- PREPARED TO MAKE SACRIFICE (MAT. 13: 44 45)




REFLECTION



- A FOLLOWER OF CHRIST IS ONE WHO FOCUSES ON CHRIST AND UTILIZES THE SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES AS THE VEHICLE TO TAKE THEM CLOSER TO HIS HEART.
- THE SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES LEAD THE FOLLOWER OF CHRIST TO THE ANSWER, JESUS CHRIST.

CONVERSION

- ACCEPTS THE INVITATION. (MT. 16:24)
- AWARENESS OF GOD'S PRESENCE, RIGHTEOUSNESS AND OF SIN IN OUR LIVES. (CONVINCING GRACE)
- CONVERSION OF THE MIND (REPENTANCE), WILLINGNESS TO ENCOUNTER THE WISDOM AND TEACHING OF CHRISTIANITY.
- JUSTIFYING GRACE (CONVERION OF THE HEART), MADE RIGHT WITH GOD, RESTORED TO GOD'S FAVOR.
- TRANSFORMING OF THE WILL



CONVERSION (CONT'D)

- REQUIRES THE IMMERSION OF OUR ENTIRE LIFE, BODY, BEHAVIORS INTO THE VALUES OF CHRIST. (MT. 5:1-12; Gal.5:22-23)
- CONVERSION DOES NOT MEAN THAT ALL SIN IS TOTALLY ERADICATED.

SANCTIFICATION (CONVERSION OF THE SPIRIT)

- SANCTIFYING GRACE: GOD'S IMAGE IS RESTORED IN THE FOLLOWER OF CHRIST. SAVED FROM THE ROOT AND POWER OF SIN.
- ENACTED BY GOD AND NOT BY OURSELVES.
- RECEIVING THE FULLNESS OF UNION WITH GOD
- SANCTIFICATION IS INITIATED AT CONVERSION. IT IS GOD'S WAY OF HEALING OUR SOULS AND CLEANSING THE CORRUPT NATURE.



SANCTIFICATION (CONT'D)

- AT THE POINT OF SANCTIFICATION, THE FOLLOWER OF CHRIST IS MADE PURE AND THEN CONTINUES TO THE STAGE OF MATURITY, A CONTINUOUS PROCESS IN CHRISTIAN PERFECTION.
 - PURITY IS RECEIVED FROM GOD, (GOD PURIFIES)
 - MATURITY IS ACQUIRED, IT IS DEPENDENT ON MAN.
- MATURITY COMES OUT OF A LIFESTYLE CONSISTING OF:
- WORSHIP, DEVOTIONAL TIME WITH GOD. STUDY OF THE WORD
- FASTING AND FELLOWSHIP WITH OTHERS
- BEING INTENTIONAL ABOUT OUR FAITH.

SANCTIFICATION (Cont'd)

- MATURITY MEANS THAT JESUS CHRIST PERFECTLY CONTROLS OUR WHOLE LIFE, WORDS, THOUGHTS, ACTIONS, ATTITUDES, DISPOSITION.
- FOR SANCTIFICATION TO OCCUR AFTER CONVERSION THERE MUST BE GROWTH. (2 PETER 1:5-7; 10B-11)
- MATURITY AND GROWTH ALSO DIFFER. GROWTH INVOLVES TRAINING, EDUCATION, DISCIPLINES, INSTRUCTION IN SPIRITUAL THINGS. (1 COR. 9:24-27)
- A SANCTIFIED PERSON IS ALWAYS DEPENDENT ON CHRIST. (John 15)
- A SANCTIFIED PERSON CAN FALL FROM SANCTIFICATION. 1 Cor.10:12.

WORSHIP

- GOD REQUIRES TRUE WORSHIPPERS (JOHN 4:23)
- WORSHIP MUST BE A PRIORITY IN EVERY FOLLOWER'S LIFE, IF THE LORD IS TO BE LORD. (MARK 12:30)
- THE DIVINE PRIORITY IS WORSHIP FIRST AND SERVICE SECOND, OUR LIVES ARE TO BE PUNCTUATED WITH PRAISE, THANKSGIVING AND ADORATION. (LUKE 10:38-42)
- SERVICE AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR WORSHIP IS IDOLTRY. (HEB.13:15; 1 PETER 2:4-5,9; ACTS. 16:25)

OBEDIENCE

- OBEY GOD REGARDLESS OF THE PERSONAL CONSEQUENCES WE MAY ENCOUNTER.
- WITHOUT BEING OBEDIENT, A FOLLOWER'S RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD WILL BE FRUITLESS.
- A FOLLOWER MUST BE PREPARED AND WILLING TO GO AND SERVE WHEN GOD REQUIRES US TO.

OBEDIENCE (CONT'D)

- REFLECT ON SAUL'S ACTION (1 SAM. 15:9)
- GOD'S RESPONSE (1 SAM. 15:20-23)
- WE MUST OBEY GOD BY DOING HIS WILL AND FOLLOWING HIS COMMANDMENTS.
- HOW WE LIVE OUR LIVES, DEVOTE TIME IN HIS WORD, STAND UP FOR CHRIST,

SUBMISSION

- REFLECT ON (MARK 8:34-38)
- A FOLLOWER OF CHRIST FINDS THEIR IDENTITY IN THE ACT OF SELF DENIAL. (JOHN 21:19; ACTS 9:16)
- SELF DENIAL IS THE ONLY SURE WAY TO LOVE OURSELVES. (MT. 10:39)

FELLOWSHIP

- THE COMMON PURPOSE AND DEVOTION THAT BINDS FOLLOWERS OF CHRIST TO EACH OTHER AND TO CHRIST.
- FOLLOWERS OF CHRIST PARTICIPATE TOGETHER IN THE SAVING POWER AND MESSAGE OF THE GOOD NEWS
- FOLLOWERS OF CHRIST SHARE A FELLOWSHIP WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT. (2 COR. 13:14)

SERVICE

- REFLECT ON JESUS' EXAMPLE OF SERVICE. (JOHN 13:14-15)
- SERVICE IS ABOUT FUNCTION AND NOT STATUS. (MATT. 20:25-28), RADICAL SELF DENIAL.
- SERVICE IS ALL INCLUSIVE (MARK 9:35)
- A FOLLOWER OF CHRIST SERVES BECAUSE THERE IS A NEED

SERVICE (CONT'D)

- FOLLOWERS OF CHRIST GUARDS THE REPUTATION OF OTHERS AND DEMONSTRATE COMMON COURTESY (TITUS 3:2)
- HOSPITALITY (1 PETER 4:9; 1 Tim. 3:2)
- BEAR EACH OTHER'S BURDENS (GAL.6:2; JAMES 2:8)

THE CROSS

- THE HEART OF THE GOSPEL (1 COR. 15:3)
- GOD'S CONCERN FOR ALL (1 TIM. 2:4)
- MOTIVATES THE FOLLOWER TO LOVE AND GOOD WORKS (2 COR. 5:14-15)

THE CROSS (CONT'D)

- TEACHES THE FOLLOWER OF CHRIST TO GIVE (2 COR. 8:5; JOHN 3:16)
- CENTRAL IN THE LIFE OF A FOLLOWER
- PROTECTS FROM THE MANY WINDS OF FALSE DOCTRINE. (1 PETER 2:24-25)

PURSUING AND DOING GOD'S WILL

- GOD'S KINGDOM IS A PRIORITY (MATT. 6:33)
- A FOLLOWER OF CHRIST DEPENDS ON THE LORD (Prov. 3:5-6)
- REFLECT ON (PHILIPPIANS 4:4-9)
