15. And how from childhood you have known the sacred writings that are able to instruct you for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

THE WORD OF GOD

- •Original Word: קה
- Transliterated: PEH
- Phonetic: PEH
- The mouth (as the means of blowing), whether literal or figurative (particularly speech);
 God speaks from his mouth.

KINGS 8:15

"Praise be to the LORD, the God of Israel, who with his own hand has fulfilled what he promised with his own mouth to my father David.

•Original Word: אָמְרָה

- Transliterated: 'IMRAH
- •Phonetic: IM-RAW'
- •Or memrah {em-raw'}; commandment, speech, word.
- •The act of speech.

DEUTERONOMY 33:9

• <u>9</u> Who said of his father and his mother, 'I did not consider them'; and he did not acknowledge his brothers, nor did he regard his own sons, for they observed your **word**, and kept your covenant.

•Original Word: דְרָר

- Transliterated: DABAR
- Phonetic: DAW-BAW'
- •A word; by implication, a matter (as spoken of) or thing;
- God's expression of himself

GENESIS 15:4

⁴ then the **word** of the LORD came to him: "this man will not be your heir, but a son who is your own flesh and blood will be your heir."

There are two Greek words used in the Greek translation of the Hebrew text or old testament and also in the new testament. 1. RHEMA 2. LOGOS

- Original Word: ἡῆμα, ατος, τό
- Transliterated: RHEMA
- Phonetic: HRAY'-MAH
- An utterance (individually, collectively or specifically); saying, word.
- An utterance from God to...

MATTHEW 26:75

⁷⁵ then peter remembered the word Jesus had spoken: "before the rooster crows, you will disown me three times." And he went outside and wept bitterly.

- Original Word: λόγος, ου,
- Transliterated: LOGOS
- Phonetic: LOG'-OS
- Something said (including the thought); by implication a topic (subject of discourse), also reasoning (the mental faculty) or motive;

MATTHEW 7:24

²⁴ "therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.

GOD SPOKE THROUGH JOHN THE BAPTIST

To get our attention god said nothing for 400 yrs. Then John spoke and testified to the coming messiah the son of God - JOHN 1:19-27.

TRANSFORMATION

THE GOSPEL AS THE SEED TO TRASFORMATION.

MAKING ADJUSTMENTS

Something spiritual and emotional happens when the gospel enter our hearts, this must be consolidated through prayer, reading the bible, studying the bible and serving.

- Transliterated:METAMORPHOO
- •Phonetic: MET-AM-OR-FO'-O
- To transform (literally or
 - figuratively, "metamorphose"): -
 - -change, transfigure, transform.



The use of the prefix meta, usually denotes separation, departure, cessation, completion, reversal, etc.



However the way it is used in this passage denotes both a movement of separation from and the accompaniment of.

So literally rendered, separation from the world, accompanied with the reading and study of the word of Christ, persons will experience change.

The gospel being the seed of change in the heart and mind of persons.





Jesus has already made the sacrifice what is required of us is consideration and a decision. Its eternal life or not!



That cost is dying to self!



Do a priority inventory.

Pay attention to prayer and your heart.



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Things could become very difficult, but please trust the process.



Always be prepared to put others interest before yours.
