

 Psalm30:11You have turned my mourning into dancing; you have taken off my sackcloth and clothed me with joy,12so that my soul may praise you and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks to you forever.
- c. The New Testament's command to Go the 72 sent. Luke 10
- d. Gal. 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ.
- **2.**Where do we as Christians fit in, in these hostile and uncertain times? Trust God, get involved and believe in God's love that Jesus Saves.
 - a. Luke 10:17The seventy-two returned with joy, saying, "Lord, in your name even the demons submit to us!"18He said to them, "I watched Satan fall from heaven like a flash of lightning.19Indeed, I have given you authority to tread

on snakes and scorpions and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing will hurt you. 20Nevertheless, do not rejoice at this, that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."

3. Throughout History and even now we are challenged to do what 1s right now -John Wesley and the saints that have followed up to this time of focused Mission work is still important and even more necessary now.
